Mount Gretna Bible Festival opens this **SUNDAY, 7 pm**, at the historic Tabernacle with Mt. Gretna's own Andy Roberts Jazz Quartet "praising God through original, spiritual jazz stylings." A campus bus, loading at 6 pm, will see you there for \$4. (The current DVD lecture series, "Civil Rights and the Supreme Court," is postponed for this weekend.)

Meanwhile, where Andy Roberts leads, the New Holland Band follows to Gretna Tabernacle, **June 25**. Viewed by many as the area's premier Patriotic band, led by Dr. Kenneth Laudermilch.
