

Bequests



Naming a charitable organization such as Cornwall Manor as a beneficiary in a will is probably the most common, and for some individuals, the easiest, way to provide a gift. You can designate a specific gift amount or percentage of the estate, and also indicate how you wish your gift to be used by Cornwall Manor. If you want your gift to be used for the Endowment Fund for Benevolent Care, it is necessary to specifically state that in your will. If you wish your gift to be used for another purpose for Cornwall Manor's general purposes, the language can simply say "for Cornwall Manor."

Sample Bequest Language:

Through a charitable bequest, a donor may leave to:

Cornwall Manor, 1 Boyd Street, P.O. Box 125, Cornwall, PA 17106-0125

a specific dollar amount or percentage of an estate for use by Cornwall Manor. Cornwall Manor is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation. The following is sample language for different donor intent. Donors should consult an attorney on the specific terms and final language of the will or addendum to a will.

Unrestricted Gift

A gift that can be used where need is greatest.

I give to Cornwall Manor, a non-profit 501(c)(3) Corporation, in Cornwall, Pennsylvania, the sum of \$ _____ for its general purposes.

Gift for a Specific Purpose

A gift that is to be used for a specific purpose.

I give to Cornwall Manor, a non-profit 501(c)(3) Corporation, in Cornwall, Pennsylvania the sum of \$ _____ to be used for [Ex. The Today, Tomorrow, Forever, Together Campaign Corson Hall or Clubhouse project.]

Endowment Fund

A gift that lasts in perpetuity.

I give to Cornwall Manor, a non-profit 501(c)(3) Corporation, in Cornwall, Pennsylvania, the sum of \$ _____, to be used for the Cornwall Manor Endowment Fund, the income only from which shall be used for benevolent care.

Residuary Bequest

Leaves any remainder after all other bequests have been paid.

All the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, I give to Cornwall Manor, a non-profit 501(c)(3) Corporation, in Cornwall, Pennsylvania for its general purposes.
